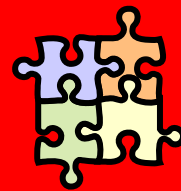

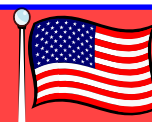

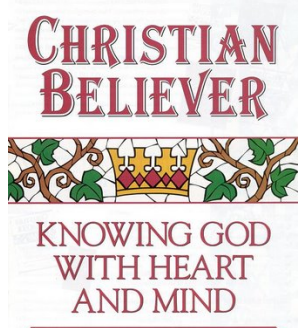

We are also still looking for some 18 yr. old+ volunteers to shadow groups, help with snack & lunch duty, & Jungle games. A few more counselors are also welcome!

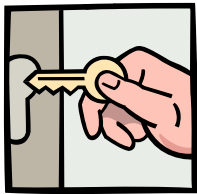

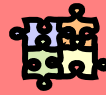
